Our Goals for Student Achievement

District Goals

The goal for Terrell County School System is to make progress in all areas with all student populations as defined by the Office of Education Accountability.

Targeted students' needs as outlined in the System Strategic Plans include:

1. The percent of students reading on grade level (within the Lexile band) as measured by the Georgia Milestone Assessments will increase by 3% by the end of the 2018-2019 SY.
2. During the 2018-2019 school year, the TCCSS will decrease the number of students scoring level 1 by 3%, increase the percentage of students scoring level 2 by 3%, increase the percent of students scoring level 3 by 3%, and increase the percentage of students scoring level 4 by 1% as measured by the Georgia Milestone Assessments.

School Goals

TMS Focus for 2018-2019:

- **Improve literacy skills in reading and math.**
- **Improve basic math skills.**

1. The percent of students reading on grade level will increase by 3% by the end of the 2018-2019 school year as measure by the beginning of the year and end of the year STAR report.
2. TMS will decrease the number of student performing at level 1 by 3%, increase the number of students performing at level 2 and level 3 by 3%, increase the number of students performing at level 4 by 1% as measure by the Georgia Milestones End of Grade Assessment (EOG).

As a school, in grades 6th-8th we will.....

- Provide parents with math packets and/or interactive notebook with instructions for solving problems every nine weeks so parents can help with homework.
- Provide parents with a word list that explains current classroom academic vocabulary every nine weeks.
- Provide parents with a packet that will include math, reading comprehension and vocabulary strategies to use at home.
- Incorporate reading ,writing, and vocabulary strategies across the curriculum and conduct parent workshops to teach parents how to use math, reading, and writing strategies.
- Maintain AR folder and make sure student checks out books on correct reading level.
- Conduct Family Fun Nights for all content areas to expose families to the school's curriculum and teach strategies to improve literacy.

As parents, we will in grades 6th-8th.....

TMS parents joined the staff to develop ideas about how families can support students' success in all content areas.

- Complete math packets with child every nine weeks
- Review vocabulary list with child nightly
- Review interactive notebooks and school website for resources
- Attend monthly math, reading, and writing strategies workshops for parents.
- Practice math facts with child nightly
- Check child's agenda for homework assignments and completion.
- Attend Family Fun Nights for all content areas.
- Read to and listen to child/children read daily.
- Reinforce teacher reading, writing, and vocabulary strategies nightly.
- Review AR folder and discuss progression toward reading goal.

Teachers, Parents, Students- Together for Success (Cont.)

As students in grades 6th-8th we will.....

- Read for 30 minutes and study notes for 20 minutes every night.
- Take flyer home for parents/guardians to inform parents of the reading, writing, and math strategies workshops and Family Fun Nights.
- Write down all homework assignments in agenda, complete, and return to school the next day.
- Complete homework assignments with parent nightly.
- Study vocabulary word list nightly
- Practice basic math fact nightly.
- Complete suggested reading and math activities in parent packet every nine weeks.
- Use teacher provided reading, writing, and vocabulary strategies daily
- Maintain AR folder and check out books weekly that are on level
- Make sure interactive notebook is current
